Mayor and Council Special Meeting  
October 5, 2016**

The Mayor and City Council met at 6:30 PM on Wednesday, October 5, 2016 in the City Council Chambers. **Present:** Mayor McCarron, Councilmembers Ebaugh, Vigliotti, Wantz and Frazier. **Also Present:** City Manager Heine, Attorney Gullo and Clerk Kalman. Councilmember Vigliotti led the Pledge of Allegiance.

The reason for the special meeting was to edit and approve **Resolution 2016 – 28 - Referendum Election**

Councilmember Wantz suggested the addition of the words “on whether” in item two (2).

Councilmember Frazier made a motion to add the word “duly” on page two. There was no second. Mayor McCarron conducted a poll of councilmembers to determine if the word “duly” should be included on page two, to define elected officials. The results were 3 in favor, with Ebaugh opposed.

Motion to recess at 6:57 to allow for the suggested revisions to be applied and the resolution to be re-printed for final review, by Ebaugh, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Wantz – 3 - 1, with Frazier opposed

The corrections were distributed and the meeting reconvened at 7:15.

Councilmember Ebaugh made a motion to adopt Resolution 2016 – 28, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Wantz – carried 3 – 1 with Frazier opposing.

Comments were received from the audience.

Motion to adjourn special meeting at 7:27 PM by Wantz, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Ebaugh – carried 4 - 0
