Mayor and Council Special Meeting  
June 1, 2017**

The Mayor and City Council met at 6:30 PM on Thursday, June 1, 2017 in the City Council Chambers.

**Present:** Mayor McCarron, Mayor Pro Tem Foster and Councilmembers Fuller, Vigliotti, Wantz and Frazier. **Also Present:** City Manager Heine, Attorney Gullo and Clerk Kalman. Mayor McCarron led the Pledge of Allegiance.

The reason for the special meeting was to discuss the Taneytown Police Department staffing issues and salary structure realignment.

Police Chief Bill Tyler addressed the Mayor and councilmembers, who had been supplied with a packet of information as well as a spreadsheet showing a cost analysis for an increase in police salaries.

Motion by Frazier to grant the implementation of Plan A, in the amount of \$135, 490.20, but with no second, the motion died

Motion by Vigliotti to add to the Mayor and Council Workshop Agenda for June 7, 2017 discussion of a budget amendment to pay \$135, 490.20 out of the reserve fund to allow for increases to police salaries, second by Frazier, carried 5 – 0.

Mayor and councilmembers received comments from the audience.

Councilmember Frazier made a motion that councilmembers would respond to an email from an individual requesting information, there was no second. Councilmember Frazier was advised that the information was on the City website.

Motion to adjourn special meeting at 7:42 PM by Wantz, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Foster carried 5 – 0.
