

**Taneytown Planning Commission
Minutes
June 27, 2016**

The Taneytown Planning Commission met, June 27, 2016 at 7:30 PM in the City Council Chambers. Chairman Parker and commission members, LeFaivre, Glass, Archie, Wantz and Naylor were present. County planning liaison Graf and City Clerk Kalman were also in attendance.

The minutes of the May 23, 2016 Planning Commission meeting were reviewed. Commission member Wantz moved to approve the minutes. The motion passed unanimously.

Commission members discussed ongoing development projects and comment letters regarding such projects.

County liaison Graf presented information about the Carroll County Bicycle-Pedestrian Master Plan and indicated that county officials would like to meet with city staff to discuss the plan in more detail.

There was a lengthy discussion about the Ordinance 26 – 2016 – Amendment to sign ordinance and the general consensus was that the diagram of a proposed new sign at Memorial Park does not fall within the parameters of city code. It was decided that the ordinance should be further explored and more detail added. Commission member Wantz stated he will draft a chart setting forth possible restrictions for each zone and present it at a future meeting.

The next meeting is scheduled for July 25, 2016. With no further business, the meeting adjourned at 8:34 PM on motion by Chairman Parker.
